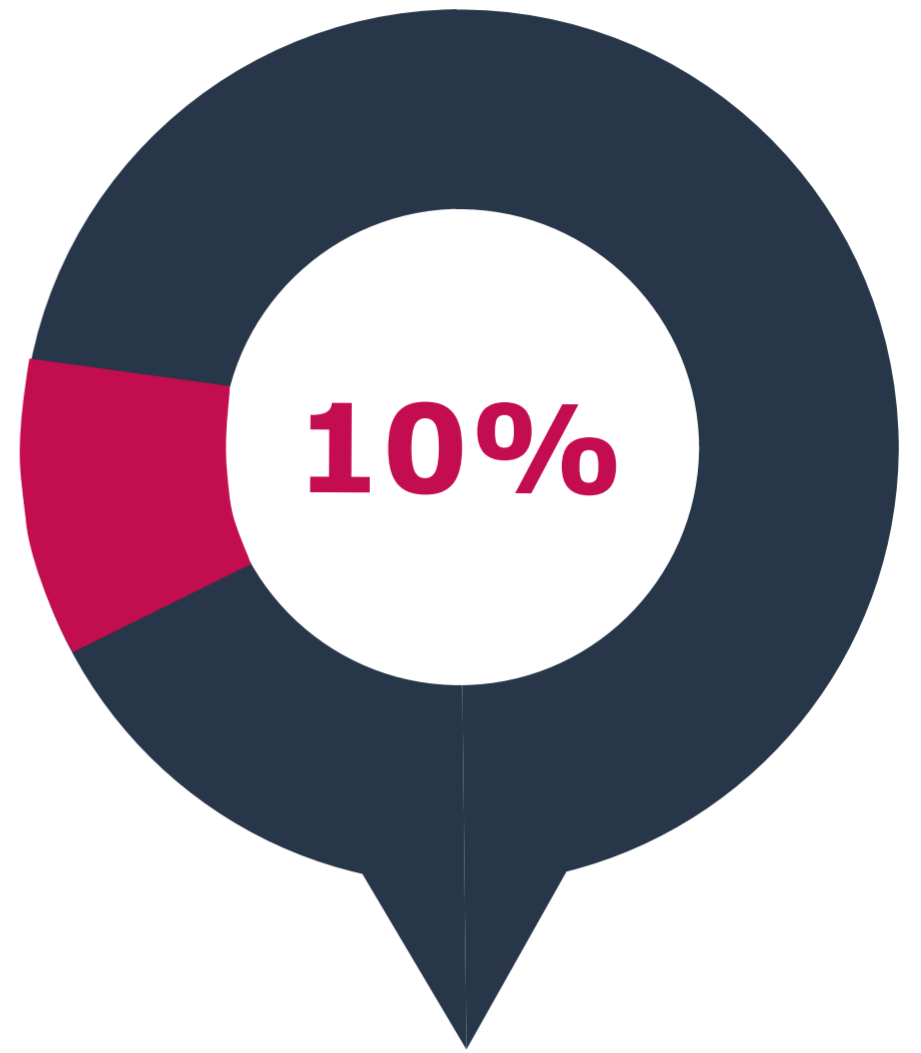


The Apprenticeship Levy Infographic

Companies with less than 50 staff will get 100% funding for apprentices aged 16-18. This means that the training will be free.

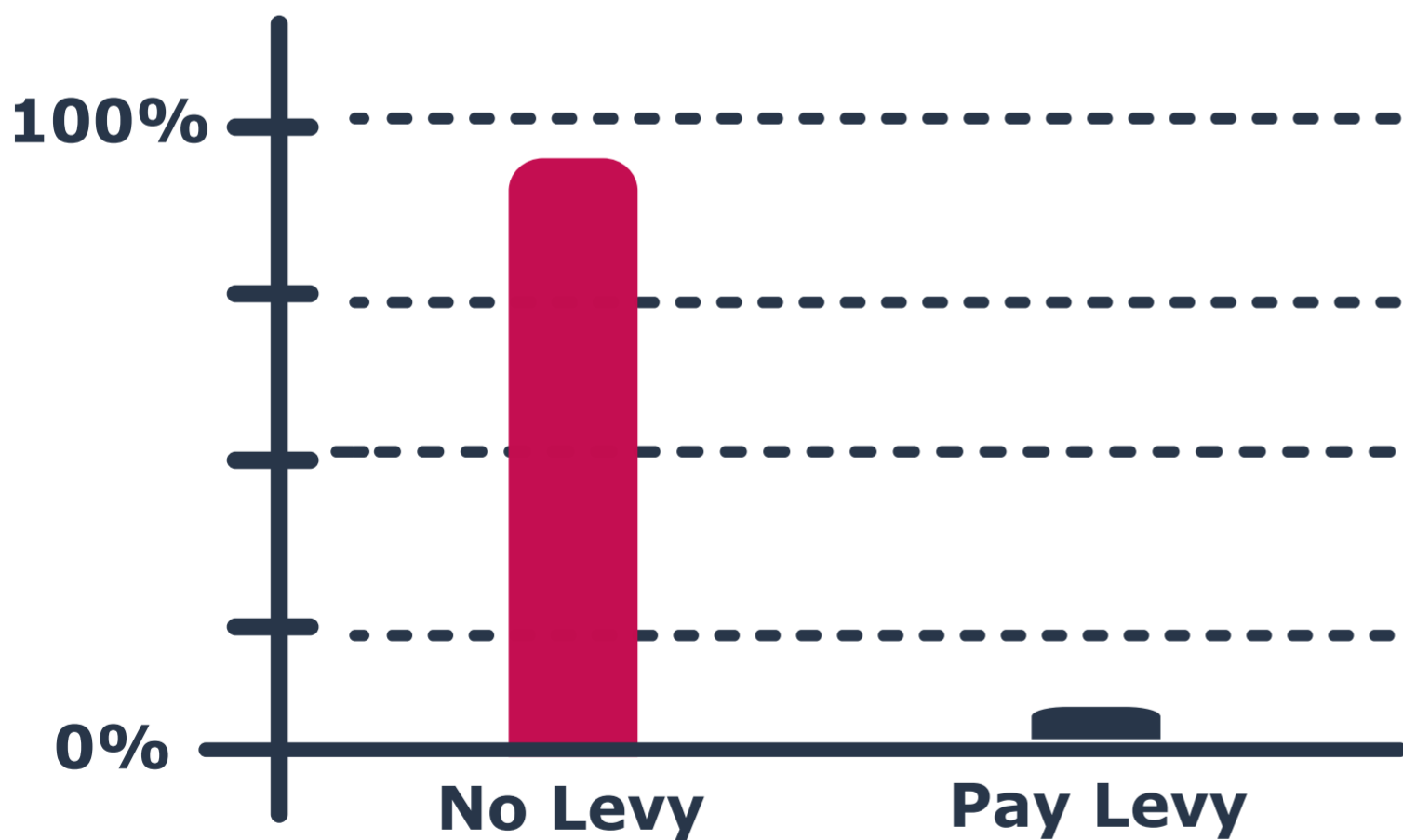


The levy will be introduced on 6th April 2017.

If you employ an apprentice aged 19-24, you may have to pay a 10% contribution.

If your wage bill exceeds £3,000,000 you pay a levy of 0.5% of your wage bill.

98% of employers will NOT have to pay the apprenticeship levy. Only 2% have a wage bill over the £3,000,000 threshold.
